



2 + 2 Articulation Agreement

and

Butler Community College Sport Management, Associate in Science (A.S.)

The purpose of this 2 + 2 articulation agreement is to provide Butler Community College students the opportunity to transfer coursework from Butler Community College (Butler CC) to Wichita State University (WSU) in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree with a major in Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management with a minor in Workforce Leadership and Applied Studies.

In addition, this articulation agreement identifies requirements, options, equivalencies, and parameters, which will benefit many students for years to come. This document also includes a program of study with a list of equivalent Butler CC and WSU courses by term for the first two years at Butler CC; and a list of WSU courses to complete upon transfer to the four-year institution.

Admission/Program/Graduation information

General Education Coursework: The completion and transfer of general education coursework will vary based on the program of study for the specific Butler CC program. General education courses must be at least three (3) credit hours and from the approved general education course list at Wichita State University. Students transferring from Butler CC are required to meet the approved general education program at WSU at the time of transfer. <u>Graduation Requirements:</u> Transfer students must complete at least 60 hours of four-year college work and 45 hours of upper division work in order to qualify for graduation from Wichita State University.

For graduation, students will need to meet all enrollment eligibility requirements at the time of transfer and/or enrollment, fulfill all WSU general education requirements and degree requirements, and must meet all requirements for graduation as outlined by WSU.

<u>Admission to WSU:</u> To apply for admission, students may contact the WSU Admission office by calling: (316) 978-3085 or WSU Office of Adult Learning by calling: (316) 978-8325. Information and applications are located online, https://www.wichita.edu/admissions/index.php.





Students transferring to WSU from BCC who have completed a degree or certificate program must meet the necessary requirements for admission to WSU, and will have their transcript evaluated on an individual basis.

Scholarship/Financial Aid: Students can inquire about scholarships, financial aid, and grants by contacting the WSU Financial Aid office (316) 978-3430 or Butler's Financial Aid Office (316) 322-3121. Students may also visit the College of Applied Studies Scholarship page for information on scholarships specific to the college, www.wichita.edu/casscholarship.

The agreement is for Butler CC students who have:

- Completed or began an Associate in Science (A.S.) degree in Sport Management
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on 24 credit hours or more
- Applied for admission to WSU*
- * If student does not meet the WSU transfer requirements, they are required to meet freshman requirements as outlined under WSU Admission requirements, https://www.wichita.edu/admissions/undergraduate/qa.php

BCC students meeting the above requirements will:

- Be admitted to WSU for the Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management with a minor in Workforce Leadership and Applied Studies with the completion of WSU application requirements and receipt of transcripts
- Be required to meet WSU General Education Policy or KBOR policy
- Be guaranteed to transfer credits (100 level and higher) up to but not exceeding 60 credit hours





This agreement is subject to revision or cancellation by either WSU or BCC if necessary.
