## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN WICHITA STATE UNIVERSITY AND CLOUD COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE May 28, 2015 Revised February 17, 2017

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide learning opportunities through a transfer agreement in regards to the Cloud County Community College (Cloud) Associate of Arts or Associate of Science Degree in Criminal Justice for those students pursuing a Bachelors of Science in Criminal Justice degree from the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences at Wichita State University. This transfer agreement will follow the guidelines in the WSU Undergraduate Catalog for all transfer students.

Students should refer to transfer sheets for the required courses at each institution. Transfer students must complete at least 60 hours of four-year college work and 45 hours of upper-division work in order to qualify for graduation from Wichita State University.

The following criminal justice courses must be completed by a Cloud student transferring to WSU with the earned AAS in Criminal Justice. This depicts criminal justice curriculum only.
