

The Office of Special Programs TRIO/GEAR UP Day will be held the week of February 17, 2020 - February 21, 2020. Historically, TRIO/GEAR UP Day activities began with the College Access, Retention, and Success (CARS) Conference inviting USD259, WSU faculty and staff, and the Wichita community to learn more about the programs offered and the students served. TRIO/GEAR UP Day has traditionally concluded with a banquet recognizing TRIO/GEAR UP alumni and their accomplishments as well as "Building Bridges" honorees, persons and organizations that have partnered and supported the TRIO/GEAR UP community.

For 2020 the eleven (11) OSP TRIO/GEAR UP programs will graciously give back to the Wichita community by hosting a week of *Service Learning*. These 11 programs will spend time with various organizations giving back to a community that has supported TRIO/GEAR UP for more than 50 years.

Program staff and students will volunteer at the following organizations: ICT Food Rescue, Kansas Food Bank, WSU Child Development Center, Wichita Habitat for Humanity, Community Food Ministry, Exploration Place, ICT SOS, and The Lord's Diner.

Deltha Q. Colvin, Associate Vice President for Special Programs, within the Division of Diversity and Community Engagement, has administered these programs on the WSU campus for 45 years and she is a proud alum of the TRIO Upward Bound Wichita Prep program, Class of 1965.
