Funding Terms and Definitions:

State General Fund

Appropriations made by the Governor and Legislature from state tax revenues.

The State General Fund-Operating Expenditures is the appropriation for general university operating expenditures including both salaries and fringe benefits and OOE.

General Fees Fund

Revenue derived from the collection of student tuition. Expenditures from general fees may be made for salaries and wages and other operating expenditures.

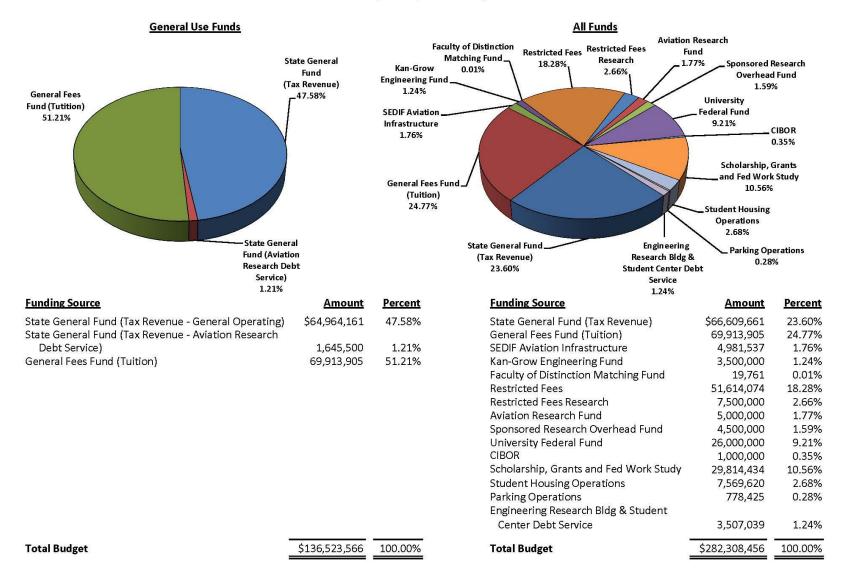
General Use Funds

The combined revenues from state tax dollars (State General Fund) and tuition revenues (General Fees).

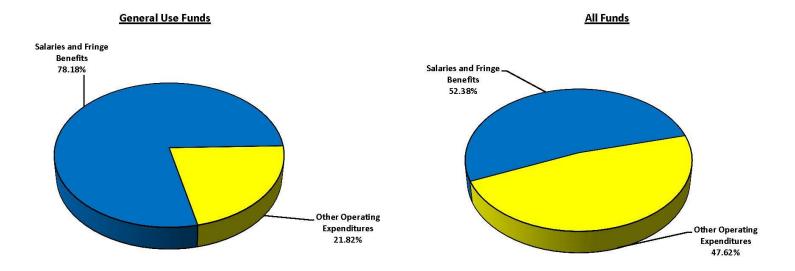
Restricted Use Funds

Special revenues that must be used solely for the specific purpose collected. Restricted fees include revenue for workshops, music events, gifts and grants for teaching and research, investment income, student fees, etc.

Student Fee – Regular Semester and Summer Session Per Credit Hour	\$35.35
Facilities Use Fee Per Credit Hour	\$ 3.60 *
University Registration Fee – Per Semester	\$17.00

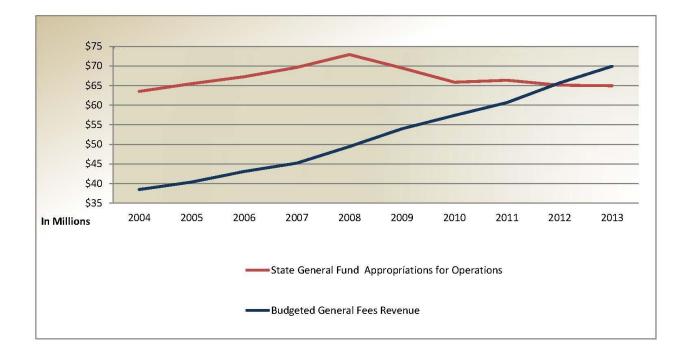
* The Facilities Use Fee is assessed to all students at the rate of \$3.60 per credit hour, per semester and summer session capping the charge at 15 credit hours (\$54.00).

Impact of Declining State Funding

Each fiscal year, the university must deal with mandated or required expenditure increases. Some of the major expenditure categories this includes are:

- Group Health Insurance premiums rates have increased 45% since FY 2009
- Other increases in fringe benefits: Worker's Compensation, Unemployment Insurance, etc.
- Faculty promotion and tenure
- Utility rate increases

Most of the additional revenue generated from tuition increases in recent years has gone towards covering these expenditure increases, as well as offsetting cuts in our state general fund appropriation.
