At Your Fingertips: Statistical Data Showing Economic Activity for Wichita, Kansas and the United States

Wichita, KS — Starting Monday, September 08, 2014, the Center for Economic Development and Business Research (CEDBR) will begin publishing indicators for Wichita, Kansas and the United States online at **www.Data.cedbr.org**. Indicators will be extracted from sources such as the Bureau of Labor Statistics and the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System. For each region, these indicators will be updated monthly and quarterly.

This new optimal format has unique benefits, not limited to:

- Easy access to data through ease of download;
- User friendly interface;
- Instant creation of charts with a simple click; and
- Embeddable and sharable data

The list of indicators will cover such information as: employment, construction and real estate, current and leading indices, average hours worked per week in manufacturing, average hourly earnings in manufacturing, electricity usage, Wichita mid-continent airport activity, prices and consumer attitudes, and interest rates.
