Shocker Bowler to Represent USA at World Youth Championships

WICHITA, Kan. – Shocker bowling's Kelsey Muther (Topeka, Kan.) has been selected as one of the eight Junior Team USA members to represent the United States at the 2012 World Tenpin Bowling Association World Youth Championships.

The eight Junior Team USA members will represent two teams, one male and one female, with four men and four women on each team.

The competition will be held June 22 to July 3 at the Blu-O Paragon Bowling Center in Bangkok, Thailand. Selections for the tournament were made after the members of Junior Team USA attended training camp at the International Training and Research Center in Arlington, Texas, earlier this month.

"It is an honor to be on the traveling team," Muther said. "I was so surprised when they called my name."

Bowlers participating in the World Youth Championships will compete for medals in five events, which include singles, doubles, team, all-events and Masters match play.

Muther earned a spot on Junior Team USA after her performance at the 2012 Team USA Trials earlier this year in Las Vegas.

She is the 43rd Shocker bowler to earn a spot on Team USA.
