Business Prospects under MERCOSUR

<u>MERCOSUR</u> is an economic and political agreement among Argentina, Brazil, Paraguay and Uruguay that has now transformed itself into a customs union. Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru and Venezuela have associate member status. <u>MERCOSUR</u> offers a huge potential market for the U.S. covering about 5 million square miles of territory, a population of 270 million and a combined GNP of \$2.9 trillion

The U.S. is MERCOSUR'S largest trade partner comprising about 25% of total MERCOSUR trade. Mercosur '5' members account for only 3.5% of total U.S. trade. but with associates & Mexico joining as an observer, prospects are greater for trade advancement. Since 1991, U.S. trade with MERCOSUR increased over 5 fold from \$ 16 billion to about \$ 88 billion dollars in 2011. U.S. exports comprised about \$ 52 billion, while imports totaled about \$ 36 billion. The U.S. owned FDI stock in MERCOSUR was about \$ 73 billion, while MERCOSUR countries in turn owned \$ 2.2 billion in U.S. FDI stock. The largest category of 2011 exports was machinery, agricultural products, fuel and oil, commercial services and aircraft. The largest category of imports was minerals and oil, machinery, iron and steel and agricultural products.

Brazil, largest MERCOSUR economy, is a premier buyer of Wichita's Aircraft.
