## Important Items to Note:

- 1. A Plan of Study must be filed after the completion of 12 hours of graduate coursework. Forms are available at wichita.edu/MBA
- 2. A grade of "C" or better is required in all courses, and an overall GPA of 3.0 must be maintained in order to graduate.
- 3. Elective coursework must be pre-approved. Cooperative Education credit may not be used toward degree requirements.
- 4. If you are planning to use courses towards the hours required to sit for the CPA exam you should avoid taking cross -listed courses such as ECON 709, consult the Kansas Board of Accounting.
- 5. We reserve the right to administratively withdraw students from courses if they have not met the required prerequisites. Certain preparatory courses are required prior to enrollment in required courses.
- 6. The MBA degree must be completed within six years from first semester of enrollment.
- 7. If courses needed for your degree are not offered in the semester/year you need them, and waiting to take them will prevent a timely graduation, please contact grad.business@wichita.edu to find appropriate substitute courses to take.
- 8. An Application for Degree should be completed within the first 20 days (or the 1<sup>st</sup> 3 weeks) of the semester that you plan to graduate. The application can be submitted up to 2 semesters prior to your graduation, however. The form can be found at Wichita.edu/Commencement
- 9. To participate in the graduation ceremony, students will need to RSVP online at Wichita.edu/Commencement. This form should be completed by mid-November for the December ceremony and mid-April for the May ceremony. There is not a summer graduation ceremony, but graduates can choose to walk the semester before or after.
