Info on the new controllers

We are getting more information on the new controller (known as Gizmo), and the technical documentation is taking shape. Documentation will be made available soon via the Registry (Annual Game Files & QnA section).



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The package will replace the Cortex, joystick, the wireless keys, and the cable used in the wired configuration. All the rest of the returnable kit will remain the same. The cost for the complete set of components is just under \$150. Much more affordable than the current solution. These will be made available for purchase soon (June is the current plan for teams). You are welcome to buy them, however please remember we will be using the Cortex for competition in 2024, both in Kansas and for Denver Regionals.
