## **Vice President's Election Report**

10 May 2021

## Faculty Electorate, Senate Representation & Seats Open for 2021-23 Term

Electorate – 562 FA/F2 faculty with  $\geq 0.5 \text{ FTE}$  appointments; representation – 1 Senator per 12 faculty in College:

- At-large Senators (6 total) President & Past President + 4 others with 2 up for election
- Applied Studies 50 faculty = 5 Senators with 3 (including NTT) up for election: CLES, HPS, & Sport Management
- Business 57 faculty = 5 Senators with 2 up for election in Accountancy & Management
- Engineering 81 faculty = 7 Senators with 4 up for election in AE, ECE, ET, & ISME
- Fine Arts 68 faculty = 6 Senators with 4 up for election, 2 At-large + Performing Arts & Music
- Health Professions 92 faculty = 8 Senators; reduction of 1 Senator required redistribution with 4 up for election + 1 Senator's term extended to rebalance when terms come up for election (4 in 2022 & 4 in 23)
- LAS Humanities 55 faculty = 5 Senators with 3 up for election
- LAS Natural Sciences & Math 70 faculty = 6 Senators with 3 up for election
- LAS Social Sciences 71 faculty = 6 Senators with 3 up for election
- Libraries 15 faculty = 2 Senators with 1 up for election

Out of 56 Senators, 30 have 2021-23 terms & 26 have 2020-22 terms which is slightly imbalanced by 2 Senators

## **Nominations & Election Process**

Nomination request & reminder email 1+ week later was sent to the relevant electorate for the 29 seats up for elections (with President-elect seat already determined). There were:

- 31 nominations\* made by the deadline (<= smaller than normal, possibly due to increased workload)
- Conducted 5 elections\* to determine the outcome of 8 seats (1 tied where tie-break rule was applied)
- Several late nominations which could not be included in the election nominee slate
- 5 seats vacant after initial call with 4 late nominations forwarded to Rules Comm & ultimately approved \*University at-large nomination was collected by Senate Executive Assistant Lee Ann Birdwell & Senate President Aleks Sternfeld-Dunn volunteered to conduct the election which turned out to be unnecessary
