







History of WSU Tech

- 1965: Wichita Area Vocational-Technical School (WAVTS) was created and recognized by the Kansas State Board of Education to serve area high schools
- 1991: Associate of Applied science degrees were awarded by WSU in conjunction with WAVTS for Electronic Engineering Technology students
- 1995: WAVTS became Wichita Area Technical College and granted the authority to award college credit and the associate of applied science degree
- 1997: General Education agreement between WSU and WATC was signed
- 1999: WATC became part of the Kansas Board of Regents






History of WSU Tech cont.

- 2004: WATC transitioned to an independent entity governed by a board of trustees
- 2008: WATC received HLC Initial Accreditation
- 2010: National Center for Aviation Training opened near Jabara Airport
- 2013: WATC is the fastest growing college in Kansas
- 2015: Shocker Pathway was started to help students transition from WATC to WSU
- 2018: WATC became affiliated with Wichita State University and became the WSU Campus of Applied Sciences and Technology








Koch Accounting Apprenticeship Program

Metallica Scholars






- \$1,000 scholarship to first time freshman

High school students get a jump on a college degree or a career with tuition-free or reduced-cost classes from WSU Tech



Through the Wichita Promise scholarship, individuals can take a short 8 to 10-week program where they receive training in a high-demand field and a guaranteed job interview most before they even finish classes.

Since its origination in the fall of 2016, over 1.4 million dollars of scholarships have been awarded and nearly 1,000 students have participated.

Fall 2022 class, eligible programs include: Aviation Sheetmetal Assembly, CNC Operator, Composite Fabrication, Process Mechanic (Paint) and health core classes for Practical Nurse, Registered Nurse and Surgical Technology.
