Academic Integrity Policy Committee

Composition: 11

9 Faculty, one chosen from each of the Senate divisions

1 AVP of Academic Administration and Outreach or designee (ex officio, non-voting)

1 Director of Student Conduct and Community Standards or designee (ex officio, non-voting)

Selection: Members are nominated by the Rules Committee to be confirmed by the Senate.

Charges:

- 1. Periodically review and propose appropriate revisions to the Academic Integrity Policy and Handbook to Faculty Senate.
- 2. Interpret AI policy and handbook for clarification upon request from faculty, Academic Integrity Committee, or SCCS.
- 3. Collaborate with SCCS about training Academic Integrity Committee members related to interpretation of the policy.
- 4. Review annual outcome data collected by SCCS.
 - a. Report the percentage of overturned cases and the common reasons, and potential systemic problems to the Senate.
- 5. Review outcomes for disparate impact and make recommendations to reduce bias.
- 6. Ensure adequate reporting-faculty opportunities to participate in the appeals process.
