Communication: President – AD - FAR

- In the current dynamic college athletics environment, frequent communication is more important than ever
- Regular and as needed communication:
 - President, AD and FAR: Meet at least quarterly
 - President AD: Meet at least twice monthly
 - AD FAR: Meet at least monthly
 - President FAR: Meet as needed
 - Sustained additional communication with other university and athletics leadership via meetings, emails, etc.
 - AD meets monthly with SGA leadership



Key Initiatives 2021-22

- Real Response Student-Athlete Reporting Application
- Name-Image-Likeness Task Force
- American Athletic Conference Academic Consortium



Real Response

- Real time, anonymous reporting application for student-athletes
- Reports received by senior athletic department officials who provide initial response and then cascade to other athletic, university personnel for subsequent action
- Adopted as key tactic in response to AY21 <u>Athletics Policy & Culture</u> <u>Task Force report</u>
- Application launched in Spring 2022



Name-Image-Likeness

- The NCAA established an NIL policy in June 2021
- Since Kansas has no state law regarding NIL, WSU developed an institutional policy in July 2021
- <u>ALTITUDE program</u> launched in partnership with Opendorse to support student-athletes in the NIL environment
 - Ready component: Training and brand value assessments
 - Social component: Content hub, publishing platform, analytics

- Fall 2021 GPA Overall Department: 3.29
- 14 Teams at 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA
- 33 Consecutive Semesters: 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA



Academic Progress Rate

- APR: NCAA academic accountability measure
 - Calculation based on retention & eligibility
 - Multiyear rate (4 Years) must exceed 930
- WSU Multiyear
 - All programs > 930
 - Two programs with perfect score
