ALLEGED INCIDENT

- Reporting Party collects information
- Reporting Party contacts student
- Faculty Member determines if grade related sanctions are necessary

NO SANCTION
Reporting is encouraged

PURSUE FORMAL AI CHARGE

SANCTIONS ASSIGNED

- Professor assigns grade related sanctions

FACULTY'S ROLE BEGINS

AI REPORT IS FILED

- Submit relevant information and documentation to SCCS via: wichita.edu/studentconduct

WRITTEN NOTICE TO STUDENT

- Details alleged violation(s)
- Informational Meeting scheduled
- Notification of rights
- Conduct Administrator contact info

SCCS'S ROLE BEGINS

INFORMATIONAL MEETING

- Reviews process rights
- Explains alleged violation(s)
- Case review
- Discusses resolution options with an individual Conduct Administrator

ACCEPTS RESPONSIBILITY, BUT NOT SANCTIONS

DOES NOT ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY OR SANCTIONS

RESOLUTION SELECTED BY SCCS FOR MULTIPLE OR EGREGIOUS VIOLATIONS

ACCEPTS RESPONSIBILITY AND SANCTIONS

INFORMAL RESOLUTION

- Finding of IN VIOLATION
- Sanctions imposed by instructor stand
- Educational Sanctions issued by a Conduct Administrator
- Meets formally with a Conduct Administrator

FORMAL RESOLUTION

- Student meets with Academic Integrity Committee
- Full range of sanctions possible

OUTCOME ISSUED

- Finding of responsibility in violation or not in violation
- Sanctions issued if in violation
