General Education Framework



General Education (GE) Requirements at Wichita State follow the KBOR system-wide GE program framework and are comprised of 34-35 credit hours organized in six discipline-based "buckets" and an institutionally designated bucket. A student who satisfies all seven buckets will complete the GE program.

Implementation Steps Completed

- 1. Review of existing approved GE courses to insure appropriate placement in each of the 7 Buckets. Review includes the courses that are not appropriate for Buckets 1-6, because they are not discipline specific, or science courses that have no lab, but may be used in Bucket 7 by students needing a substitute for First Year Seminar or Diversity course. To be completed by May 15, to be submitted by June 1.
- 2. Review of all program requirements to identify majors that may need an exception to a bucket requirement. To be completed by July 15 for submission by July 30.
- 3. Review of all program requirements to identity majors that require courses with GE attribute that transfer students will have to take regardless of GE completion. To be completed by July 15 for submission by July 30.
- 4. Begin work in departments/colleges to submit required program changes through the established curriculum process. Begin in 2023 Fall semester, with completion of Curricular change process by Dec 15, 2023.
- 5. Fall 2023. Begin process of degree audit changes in Banner system. To be completed by Jan 30, 2024.

Implementation Steps In Process

- 1. Update all major degree check-sheets to new GE requirements.
- 2. Update all university/college/department websites regarding GE requirements.
- 3. Completion of Degree Maps for all programs
- 4. Revise UG Catalog to conform to curricular changes
- 5. Transcript notation revision to include completion of GE
- 6. Math Pathways
- 7. English Pathways

Implementation KBOR Actions and Pending

- Course Lists for each bucket approved
 - New and revised course list submitted for approval February 1
- Exceptions Requests
 - All approved except Dental Hygiene
 - Approval of Exception Requests for 1 year (conditional approval)
 - Elementary Education blanket approval after statewide institutional agreement
 - Engineering Blanket approval
- KBOR is creating 4 groups to create 60 credit systemwide transfer agreement
 - Business Administration
 - Nursing
 - Computer Science
 - Social Work

- Revised Course list currently with KBOR for approval by March 1
- New requests for exceptions due May 31
- Annual process for reviewing Course lists to be developed by KBOR
- Implementation of Math and English Pathways
- WSU General Education Committee review of WSU General Education.
