Recommendations from the Rules Committee

- Senate Rule V.2.d relating to elections states that no more than twice the number of nominees per open position will be listed on the ballot (in other words if there are more than 4 nominees for 2 positions, then ONLY the four with the most nominations would be placed on the ballot. The Practice has been to place everyone nominated on the ballot. Do we want to change the policy to match the practice, or conform to the policy?
 - > **Recommendation**: Change Senate Rules to remove this restriction. The reality is that we often get many candidates with only one nomination, so there is no way to distinguish which nominees should be placed on the ballot.
