ACADEMIC PROBATION

Students in the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences are placed on academic probation whenever their cumulative or WSU grade point average (GPA) falls below 2.00 and they have attempted at least 6 hours at Wichita State University.

STEPS YOU MUST COMPLETE WHILE ON ACADEMIC PROBATION

While you are on academic probation, you may register for classes if you have completed the following steps:

- 1. Fill out the Academic Recovery Plan and Self-Assessment worksheet.
- 2. Bring your completed Academic Probation Contract and Self-Assessment worksheet to your academic advising appointment. Be prepared to discuss your completed form as well as your goals for the term and changes you will make to improve your academic performance.
 - Please call (316) 978-4757 or stop by 115 Grace Wilkie Hall to schedule an appointment.
 - If you do not bring your completed forms to this appointment you will be required to reschedule.

ACADEMIC PROBATION REQUIREMENTS

As an LAS student, you must meet these minimum academic requirements during your probation semester in order to avoid dismissal from the University.

- Complete the Academic Recovery Plan and required probation meeting(s) by the end of the seventh week of the term.
- Earn at least a 2.00 or better term GPA.
- Meet any additional requirements of your plan and/or Academic Advisor.

DISMISSAL

Failure to earn the required minimum GPA of 2.0 will result in your dismissal from Wichita State University.

At that time, you will be dropped from any courses you have enrolled in for future semesters and will not be eligible to register at Wichita State University. You are encouraged to consult your academic advisor for guidance and support during that time. In order to be readmitted to the university, you will need to submit an Application for Exceptions to the Exceptions Committee to have your status reconsidered.

Readmission is not automatic. You will need to demonstrate that you have made changes that will help facilitate a successful return to Wichita State University.
