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WHAT IS A COMMUNITY MOBILIZER??

A mobilizer is a person who brings people together and gets things moving.

The Community Mobilizer position will help strengthen and grow the capacity of our Kingman County Health Coalition through coordination, community engagement, assessment, and action to help get things running smoothly.

This is a <u>part-time</u> (avg 15-20 hrs/week), <u>one-year</u>, <u>grant-funded position</u>, with the potential for future years dependent on grant funding. \$22/hr.

• Disseminates information about projects and initiatives in a variety of forums and formats (e.g., written, public speaking)

- Plan and facilitate meetings
- Direct needs assessment activities
- Facilitate Capacity Planning
- Conduct community activities as agreed upon by Coalition
- Complete and submit all mandated reports and deliverables in grant agreement with KDADS by dates due.
- Participate in trainings as mandated in grant agreement
- Participate in individual and group calls as scheduled by KDADS or DCCCA
