- 1. A scholarship or fellowship will be awarded annually to a student enrolled full or part time at Wichita State University in the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts & Sciences, Department of Mathematics.
- 2. No recipient will be excluded from consideration based on race, religion, color, national origin, gender, age, sexual orientation, marital status, status as a Vietnam Era Veteran or disability.
- 3. The award may be given to an undergraduate or graduate student.
- 4. Recipient must be enrolled in at least ten (10) semester hours.
- 5. Recipient must be a mathematics major.
- 6. Student must maintain an overall GPA of 2.5 and a 3.0 GPA in the Department of Mathematics courses.
- 7. The award is to be split equally over two semesters.
- 8. An award shall not exceed full annual tuition, fees, and cost of books. If the available amount exceeds this cost, an additional full or partial scholarship may be granted.
- 9. The Scholarship Office, a department within the Division of Campus Life and University Relations of Wichita State University, will administer the scholarship/fellowship and make the award based on the recommendation submitted by the Department of Mathematics.
- 10. The scholarship/fellowship may be renewed.
