- 1. Scholarships/fellowships will be awarded annually to one or more undergraduate or graduate students enrolled full-time at Wichita State University in the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences Department of Mathematics, Statics, and Physics.
- 2. No recipient will be excluded from consideration on the basis of race, religion, color, national origin, gender, age, sexual orientation, marital status, political affiliation, status as a veteran, genetic information or disability.
- 3. Undergraduate scholarship support is restricted to mathematics majors or, in exceptional cases, undeclared students in the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.
- 4. Graduate fellowship support is restricted to students enrolled in a graduate degree program in mathematics or applied mathematics.
- 5. Recipient(s) must have and maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
- 6. Award will be made without regard to financial need.
- 7. The Scholarship Office of Wichita State University will administer the scholarship and/or the fellowship and make the award based on the recommendation(s) submitted by the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, Mathematics, Statistics and Physics Department.
- 8. The award(s) may not be automatically renewed, but the current recipient(s) may re-apply.
