



Regular Program (63 Credits)

The School of Social Work offers the Regular Program of study for applicants not having a baccalaureate degree in Social Work from a BSW program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education. The Regular Program requires 63 total credit hours of course work which includes 38 credits hours of core courses, 9 credit hours of elective courses and 16 credit hours of practicum. The Thesis option requires the normal 63 credit hours of course work, including 3 credit hours of Thesis (SCWK 800). Thesis hours may count for 3 of the required 9 elective hours. (See paragraph on Thesis Option in Graduate Catalog.)
