Wichita State's **ShiftSpace Gallery** is located off the main lobby of **Groover Labs** at 334 N. St. Francis Avenue in downtown Wichita, Kansas. Its hours are 8 a.m.–5 p.m. Monday–Friday. The gallery is also open from 6–9 p.m. on the first Friday of each month for Wichita's First Friday gallery crawl.

- 1. What is the title of the exhibition?
- 2. Using the gallery sheets or labels on the wall, who are some of the artists showing in the exhibition?
- 3. Using the six roles of art from Mark Getlein's book, *Living with Art*, write about one individual artwork present in the gallery and how it fit within these roles (in one to two paragraphs)

OR

Write 2-3 sentences about how an individual work aligns with each of these six roles.

(Each of these roles may not apply to ALL works)

The six roles of art:

- 1) Create places for some human purpose.
- 2) Create extraordinary versions of ordinary objects.
- 3) Record and commemorate.
- 4) Give tangible form to the unknown.
- 5) Give tangible form to feelings and ideas.
- 6) Refresh our vision and help us to the world in new ways.
