## ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR OF ARTS

- o LITERATURE: Requirement can be met with either English 230 or 232 (Humanities) or a Foreign Literature course (Humanities)
- o AMERICAN POLITICAL SYSTEM: Requirement can be met with either History 131 or 132 (Humanities) or Political Science 121 (Social Science)
- NATURAL SCIENCE: Requirement can be met with an introductory laboratory class in Biology, Chemistry, Geology, or Physics
- FOREIGN LANGUAGE: Must demonstrate proficiency at a level equivalent to five hours beyond the 112 course in one foreign language OR

MINOR other than MUSIC: Must complete a minor in a discipline other than music.

STUDENTS MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF 45 CREDIT HOURS IN COURSES NUMBERED 300 OR ABOVE

ALL COURSES IN GENERAL EDUCATION MUST BE AT LEAST THREE HOURS EACH AND FROM THE APPROVED LIST

NOTE: Each degree granting college/school and major department may have its own requirements in addition to the minimum University GEP requirements listed.
