**TOTAL HOURS REQUIRED IN GENERAL EDUCATION AS FOLLOWS:**

- o **BASIC SKILLS:** 12 hours minimum All must be completed in the first 48 college hours with a grade of C or above
- o **INTRODUCTION TO THE DISCIPLINES :** 21 hours minimum (no courses in the student's major discipline / department)
- o **FURTHER STUDY IN THE DISCIPLINES AND ISSUES & PERSPECTIVES:** 9 hours minimum (no courses in the student's major discipline / department) At least one, but not more than two issues and perspectives courses

**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR OF ARTS**

- o **LITERATURE:** Requirement can be met with either English 230 or 232 (Humanities) or a Foreign Literature course (Humanities)
  - o **AMERICAN POLITICAL SYSTEM:** Requirement can be met with either History 131 or 132 (Humanities) or Political Science 121 (Social Science)
  - o **NATURAL SCIENCE:** Requirement can be met with an introductory laboratory class in Biology, Chemistry, Geology, or Physics
  - o **FOREIGN LANGUAGE:** Must demonstrate proficiency at a level equivalent to five hours beyond the 112 course in one foreign language
- OR**
- MINOR other than MUSIC:** Must complete a minor in a discipline other than music.

**STUDENTS MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF 45 CREDIT HOURS IN COURSES NUMBERED 300 OR ABOVE**

**ALL COURSES IN GENERAL EDUCATION MUST BE AT LEAST THREE HOURS EACH AND FROM THE APPROVED LIST**
