# **Option 3: AMENDED General Education Policy** (w/ AA or AS from KS Community Colleges)

• 6 Hours of 300 level or above taken at WSU

### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- Students must have a minimum of 45 credit hours in courses numbered 300 or above
- A minimum of 120 hours are required for any Bachelor's Degree
- Consult Undergraduate Catalog for additional graduation requirements
- File an Application for Degree

#### TOTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR DEGREE:

General Education (36 hours) + Music Requirements (84hours) = TOTAL: 120 hours
