## THANK YOU JO ZAKAS LEGACY FOUNDATION

The School of Performing Arts values student learning in the creation of new works and roles as an essential skill for today's arts and entertainment industries. Applied knowledge, learned through collaborative creation in the performing arts, greatly expands students' career preparation and opportunities.

The Musical Theatre Incubator Program began in 2022 with a focus on ensuring musical theatre majors had an opportunity to learn creative processes for original new musicals. This was only made possible by the generous support of the **Jo Zakas Legacy Foundation** whose primary purpose is "to assist in providing training and support of individuals and groups who would help produce more effective citizens and entrepreneurs." In 2024, the incubator program was officially renamed the *Jo Zakas Musical Theatre Incubator Program*. This served to recognize the role the foundation has played in establishing and continuing to support this innovative program.
