

NOTES

Bela Kiralyfalvi National Student Playwriting Competition

The Wichita State University National Playwriting Contest was created in 1974 by Bela Kiralyfalvi, Ph.D., Theatre Professor and Director of the School of Performing Arts until his retirement in 2003.

At WSU, Kiralyfalvi taught acting, playscript analysis, playwriting and developed an improvisation course. Although he served as Director for many years, he claimed his most satisfying highlight was simply being as a teacher. "Teaching has always been exciting and interesting. I've enjoyed learning and understanding things better through the process. I joke with students when they are getting ready to graduate after for or five years. They'll say, 'Oh I am going to be so glad to get out of here.' I tell them, 'You know, I've spent 45 years in college, and I still haven't left.' And it's true you never cease to be a student. If you cease to be a student, you will not be a good teacher."

The playwriting competition is open to all undergraduate and graduate students enrolled at any college or university in the United States. The selected playwright's script is workshopped, culminating in either a staged reading or a fully realized production by the WSU School of Performing Arts Program. In 2021, *Go Like Saints* by Skye Robinson Hillis was chosen, and is now being actualized on the Welsbacher stage.

About the Playwright



Skye Robinson Hillis (she/her) is a playwright, director, teacher, and dramaturg based in Washington, DC, previously of Chicago. Skye is a two time semi-finalist for the Princess Grace Award, and her work has been seen at the Kennedy Center's ACTF, Creede Repertory, The Route 66 Theatre Company, Chicago Dramatists, A Red Orchid Theatre, Piven Theatre Workshop, Artistic Home, Prologue Theatre Company, Polarity Ensemble Theatre, Ohio University, Columbia College, and the City of Chicago's In the Works Play Lab at the Pritzker Pavillion in Millenium Park. Her play AND VASTER was awarded a residency at the New Works Lab at Stratford in 2015, winner of the 2015 Ashland New Plays Festival, and winner of the Holland New Voices Award at the Great Plains Theatre Conference in 2017. As a director and dramaturg, she has worked for Hartford Stage, Goodman Theatre, Court Theatre, A Red Orchid, Remy Bumppo, Stage Left, and more. Her other plays include THE MARTHA MITCHELL Mitchell EFFECT, BURY THE REST, ESCAPE VELOCITY, THE ORDINARINESS OF EVERYTHING ELSE, THE RUNNING MATE, INTO PLACE, and SELFISH. Skye has an MFA in Playwriting from Ohio University.

About Go Like Saints

"Go Like Saints, is about the Hollywood Blacklist, set during the HUAC hearings in 1951, centering on the relationship between two female friends who must choose between their friendship and their careers as subpoenas begin tearing the town apart. My thesis play centers on the oft-ignored women who contributed mightily to the breaking of the Watergate scandal and the eventual resignation of Richard Nixon. What has become painfully clear to me is that, in this country and in the American theatre, anti-racism is not done and neither is feminism. In the year 2021, we are still grappling with a predominantly white cis male industry and, as a result, we are not hearing the voices we should be hearing. We are not allowing the most important stories to be told. But some of us will keep on writing them". ~ Skye


