DIRECTOR'S NOTE

About the Production

First, it is such an honor to be a part of the Wichita State University School of Performing Arts. The faculty, staff, and students are superb, and it is a pleasure to direct a staged reading of *The Fox Sisters* as my first show at WSU.

The Fox Sisters was written by Jessica Penzias, Anthony De Angelis, and Christyn Budzyna, and I had the good pleasure of working with Anthony when I was music directing a production of *A New Brain* at Penn State University. Anthony was an undergraduate playing keyboard in the pit band.

Cut to more than ten years later, when Anthony contacted me about the possibility of producing a children's show they were writing for my theatre company in State College, PA. We did and it was extraordinarily successful. So much so, I asked the trio if they were working on anything else. The immediate response was *The Fox Sisters* and weirdly enough, I had heard of the siblings and knew vaguely what the subject might be like as a musical. I said I would be extremely interested. Cut to...the pandemic. COVID-19 put a reading of the show on hold until March of 2022. The authors attended that reading and revised the show based on what they heard and saw.

In the meantime, I was offered a position at Wichita State and talked a lot about the importance of doing new work. My colleague Amy Baker Schwiethale was fully supportive as was Director of the School of Performing Arts, Cheyla Clawson Chandler. In fact, a new fund was set up for the development of new works called the Musical Theatre Incubator Program, funded by the Jo Zakas Legacy Foundation. This means *The Fox Sisters* is the first of many new shows that will be developed at Wichita State. Lots to be grateful for!

The fact that you are here to see this show means you are a part of the development process. Musicals cannot be developed in a vacuum. They must be seen, and your reactions help guide the authors in shaping the material.


Catie Wolff
