- Approval of minutes from 11/8/21 meeting
 - 7-2 (MS abstained, AM not on committee)
- Discussion of Freshman Design Experience Proposal Anthony Muscat (Dean, College of Engineering)
 - Document distributed via OneDrive
 - AM has been speaking to local businesses/companies about engineering grads, and employers have indicated that graduates need more applied learning experience
 - o Engineering faculty interested in design experience classes
 - Students as partners, not customers
 - Proposed= 2 semester class. 2 credit course in 1st semester, 1 credit in spring semester
 - AR concerned about interest from students in 2/1 credit hour classes, and that there won't be 1 instructor per 24 students
 - GC= said SF is degree audit expert in terms of what issues we'd have with making degree audit work with having two courses that are both graded, perhaps same subj/numb, fulfill the FYS requirement on a student's audit
 - Classes would be graded pass/fail (credit/no credit or satisfactory/unsatisfactory at WSU)
 - Threshold for passing= C or better work
 - Failing= D or lower work
 - They want to pilot this model next semester with the 3 credit class, then be fully available next AY (23)
 - Revisit this topic at next meeting (Dec. 10th)
