NOTES: All fees are based on a 5 month period for a fall or spring semester.

- Figures are estimates given by Host University. Figures were given in host currency and converted to United States Dollars using a floating exchange rate.
As of 07/20/22, 1 Euro (EUR) = 1.02 (USD)
- Accommodations given from the university for off campus apartments are calculated at 350 Euros per month plus a rent deposit that may be returned at the end of the stay. Utilities and internet are also included at an additional 60 Euros per month.
- Meals calculated for approximately 250 euros per month for length of stay. The University of Deusto has a coffee shop/restaurant on campus with hot food and snacks.
- For local transportation within Bilbao (i.e. Bilbobus, metro, tram or taxi) the University gives an estimate of 30 Euros for a monthly transportation pass.
- No exact estimate was provided by the partner university, however we estimate that you should not spend over \$150 for textbooks for one semester.
- The university provides insurance at 1.72 euros a day. At 152 days (5 months) this is approximately 261.44 euros. An estimated bank transfer fee of \$70 is also included in the estimate.
- Student Visa is required in Spain for those whose time of study exceeds 90 days. Personal appearance is required at the Spanish consulate in Chicago. Translation is needed for some visa documents and requires a translation fee. **This is not included in this budget.** The visa fee is \$160.
- Airfare cost was provided according to Orbitz as of July 2022 with travel dates of January 12, 2023 – June 8, 2023. This should provide a good estimate to cover the airfare expense.
- Personal expense estimates are provided by Financial Aid for students living on the WSU campus, which will be similar during a study abroad program.

*** Tuition and Fees are based on the Resident rate for 12 undergraduate credit hours at Wichita State University. Students will pay their current tuition rate during the study abroad program based on their residency and any specific college/department requirements.**

Disclaimer: All costs are estimates and subject to change. Some universities will require payment for accommodations in advance as well as other fees. In order to apply for visas, students may be required to show proof of funds, such as bank statements, to live in a host country. Please note extra travel expenses are not included. Budget accordingly.
