

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT  
 BETWEEN  
 WICHITA STATE UNIVERSITY AND HIGHLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
 May 28, 2015  
 Revised February 17, 2017

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide learning opportunities through a transfer agreement in regards to the Highland Community College (Highland) Associate of Arts in Criminal Justice degree for those students pursuing a Bachelors of Science in Criminal Justice degree from the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences at Wichita State University. This transfer agreement will follow the guidelines in the WSU Undergraduate Catalog for all transfer students.

Students should refer to transfer sheets for the required courses at each institution. Transfer students must complete at least 60 hours of four-year college work and 45 hours of upper-division work in order to qualify for graduation from Wichita State University.

The following criminal justice courses must be completed by a Highland student transferring into WSU with the earned AA in Criminal Justice. This depicts criminal justice curriculum only.

 CJ407 Introduction to research (WSU)  
 CJ593 Crime causation and criminal justice policy (WSU)

 English 210 Composition: Business, professional, and technical writing


- 18 Hours of Criminal Justice courses taken at Highland

    - May take up to 14 additional elective hours in CJ at WSU not to exceed 50 CJ credit hours
- 6 credit hours of correlate core courses taken at WSU
- Students must also satisfy the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (including the foreign language requirement) and the university's requirements for the Bachelor of Science Degree.




