

Pre-Screening Questions for COVID-19

PI or research staff are encouraged to contact all research participants prior to the participant coming to campus to conduct symptom monitoring and to inform the participants of the requirements of WSU's protocols for coming to the WSU campus, including but not limited to symptom monitoring, face covering, and social distancing.

Initially, ask the participant if they are still interested in participating in the research study. If participant says yes, continue with pre-screening tool. If they cannot be screened, postpone their research session until screening can take place or, if they are no longer interested, withdraw them from the study.

Questions relating to COVID-19 symptoms, possible exposures and travel:

Have you experienced any of the following symptoms (even if they were mild) in the past 14 days?

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fever
- Chills
- Muscle pain
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell

Have you been in close contact with any person experiencing symptoms or confirmed case of COVID-19?

Have you traveled the last 14 days? If so, to what locations?

Participants that report any symptoms of COVID-19 or possible exposure within the last 14 days are not permitted to participate in HSR research at WSU at this time.

The PI of the study is responsible for assessing any reported travel in the last 14 days and deciding if the subject should continue with the research study or not based on the latest information reported from the CDC regarding hot spots, etc.

This information is considered private information that must be stored securely.
