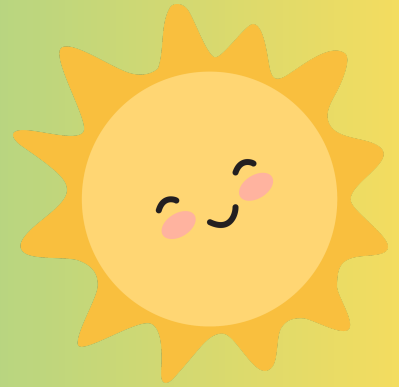

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR



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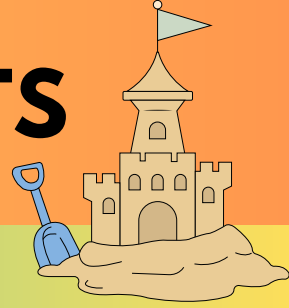
Reflection of 2022-23 school year special note:

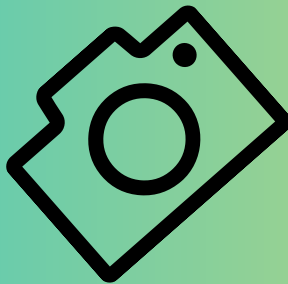
