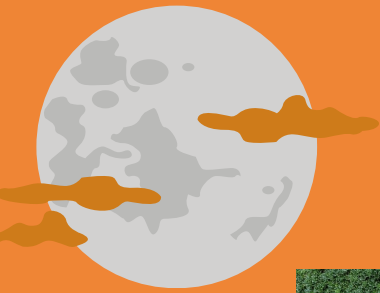

This program is 100% free to eligible veterans and can help veterans who struggle with motivation, knowledge of the application process. We have programs to build skills in math and language arts to help veterans pass entrance exams. Other services we offer are mentoring, career counseling, tutoring, resume building, forms assistance, practice exams, even Rosetta Stone for learning a new language.

## Veterans Coming Home Salute 2020



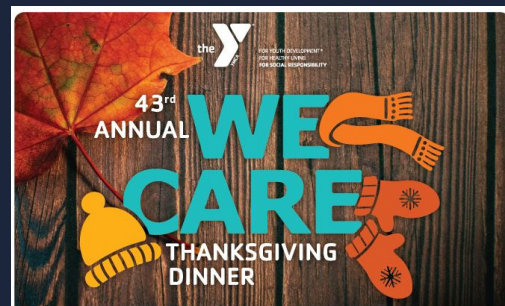
