Documentation of Service for Immediate Participation in the WSU ICAA Mandatory Retirement Plan

WSU ICAA Retirement Plan requires that eligible employees must be employed for one year prior to their participation in the Retirement Plan. Participation in the basic retirement plan is mandatory when an employee becomes eligible to participate. Participation is a condition of employment.

If the employee provides documentation, no later than 90 days after the date of appointment, the one-year waiting period will be waived if you were covered, as a result of employment with an institution of higher education located in the United States, by a retirement plan or program to which employer contributions were made for at least one year (365 days) within the five-year period immediately preceding employment with Wichita State University. In addition, if the employee was in a position eligible for benefits under any mandatory State of Kansas retirement plan with respect to which their participation was mandatory and they became part of that plan, all service while in that position will be credited toward the one year of service requirement.

Employment as a (i) student, (ii) seasonal or temporary employee, or (iii) employee who works less than halftime per year shall not count toward the satisfaction of the Year of Service requirement.
