I am a also a Scientist on the Multiplexing team at NeoGenomics, a contract research organization that specializes in cancer diagnostics. Relevant Skills gained: Python automation, Direct Communication w/ medical providers, Tumor imaging & analysis, Biotech Client Communication.



PhD focus: During my doctoral studies, I built and analyzed simple & robust self-assembled vascularized human tissue models to model aging, healing, chronic diseases. With the project I learned experimental and device design. Data analysis during my PhD focused on volumetric imaging and automated quantification via custom image analysis algorithms designed in MATLAB. (TIME lab: Tissue, Injury, and mortality engineering; University of California, Riverside). PhD in Bioengineering earned in 2021.

# McNair Fee Waivers/Fellowships

The Council for Opportunity in Education (COE), in conjunction with the Council of Graduate Schools (CGS), has compiled a list of McNair incentives to help Scholars find graduate schools that offer application fee waivers and/or fellowships and other opportunities that are available to McNair Scholars.

#### Highlighted Fellowship: Emporia State University

McNair Scholars are eligible to apply for a two-year scholarship of \$2500 per year. The scholarship is guaranteed for two years provided the recipient maintains a 3.0 gpa each semester. Applicants will be required to complete the graduate admissions application. The graduate application fee will be waived for McNair Scholars with proof of McNair Scholar status. The scholarship may be used to pay tuition/fees for any program of graduate study at Emporia State University. All award recipients must be accepted to a graduate program of study and will be required to enroll in at least six credit hours as a graduate student during the semester in which they receive the award payment.
