#### What is Panopto?



- Create videos, even using your phone
- Store videos (works like YouTube)
- Share videos with others, from class-to-class



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#### Advantages of Panopto



- Has an easy, browser-based capture option, and you can also use a Panopto recorder on your phone
- It allows long-term storage and reuse of videos
- Can embed quiz questions
- Can capture multiple screens
- It keeps your Blackboard classes "lighter" and less likely to have technical problems
- Has the ability to accept student video assignments





#### Panopto's Organization



- Panopto chooses between two possible destinations
  - "My Folder": your personal folder. Also where all your Zoom-to-Panopto sessions will go the first time (more on that on the next slide)
  - A dedicated folder tied to your course
- It's important to learn where your videos go, so login to Panopto directly to look around: Wichita.hosted.Panopto.com



# Zoom to Panopto: So Easy!



- Simply use your WSU-provided Zoom account
- Choose "record to cloud"
- Your video will automatically be saved in your "My Folder" area of Panopto
- Everyone has a Panopto account, but if you've never used it, login to it first at Wichita.hosted.Panopto.com



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# Browser-based Video Capture



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- Panopto has a recorder that you can download to your computer, but that requires admin access
- You can get to the Panopto recorder directly from your class, but you need to be in Chrome to use the browser-based option


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- Panopto's "downloaded" recorder works too, and is easy to add if you have admin access to your computer
- Access at Wichita.hosted.Panopto.com
- If you don't have access, contact HelpDesk for help
- Allows offline recording
- There is also a recorder for your smart phone: choose the "three dots" and "enter site manually" then type in Wichita.hosted.Panopto.com



# Using Panopto in Your Classes


- Panopto works a lot like YouTube, but it's a closed environment, not an open one
- That means you have to give each course access to your videos
- We do that in Bb Original through "configuring," which makes a folder for this instance of the course and gives you the opportunity to add other folders
- You might consider making special folders by class to make this process easier






## Finding Panopto in Ultra Classes


- Panopto is available in both Original and Ultra, but the tools are different
