

Building Reports (Instructors)

(*Not all features may be enabled)

Step 1. You can access your Course Evaluations & Surveys account in two ways:

1. <u>Logging in to your LMS and clicking on the established evaluations link</u>. In your LMS, you will see a link entitled something similar to "Course Evaluations and Surveys" or "Course Survey" (this depends on what has been enabled by the primary admin) and will click on that tab to be taken directly to your account. No username/password is required.

2. <u>Clicking on the link in an email sent by the main administrator</u> (if applicable). Clicking on this link will take you directly to your account. No username/password is required.

Step 2. Once you see the Course Evaluations & Surveys site, click on the "Results" tab. This will present a list of dropdown reporting menu options (not all may be enabled):


