Application for Kansas Resident Classification for Indigenous American Students

(per 2023 HB 2184, page 163)

The Kansas Legislature enacted a provision to allow particular students enrolling at a public institution of higher education in Kansas to have residency status for the purpose of paying tuition. This provision is in place from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 with anticipated annual renewal through the Legislature.

Students who are enrolled as a member of any of the following Nations are eligible, regardless of the location of their residence. ☐ The Kickapoo Tribe of Indians of the Kickapoo Reservation in Kansas; ☐ The Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation; ☐ The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska; ☐ The Sac and Fox Nation of Missouri in Kansas and Nebraska.
