- 2. Individuals must present their Shocker Cards to the Competitive Sports staff in order to participate each night. These cards must be validated for the current semester.

Entry Procedures

- Players must sign up online on IMLeagues.com
- All players are required to complete the captains or participant quiz. The purpose of these quizzes are to inform participants of rules, policies, and procedures

Rules of Play

1. Schedule:

The league format will be pool play, followed by a single-elimination bracket playoff system.

If your team is unable to make it to your game be sure to contact the IM office at 316-978-5284 by 3pm the day of or 3pm Friday for Sunday games and you will be given a default instead of a forfeit.

2. Scoring:

All matches will be played best two out of three to 25points. Teams must win by two points, with a cap at 28 points. If a third game is required, it will be played to 15 points with a cap of 17 points. All games will be played with rally scoring; a point scored will be scored on each attempted serve. There is no mercy rule, however, there is a 45-minute time limit for games. At the 45-minute mark, whichever team is winning the game is declared the winner. If it is tied, the next point will win.

3. Time-Outs

Teams are allowed two time-outs per match.

4. Team Rosters

Teams may have up to 16 players on their roster. The game shall be played between two teams of six play ers each. Four players are required to start the game to avoid a forfeit. In CoRec, teams of four must play with a player/gender ration of 2:2. Teams of six must play with a player/gender ratio of 3:3.
