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COOPERATIVE EDUCATION/INTERNSHIP

You work 40 hours per week for one semester or 20 hours per week for two semesters in a co-op or internship.

- You must enroll in a zero or one credit hour "Co-op Education" course in your department.
- The activity is approved by the Career Development Center.
- Visit wichita.edu/careerdevelopment for more information.

UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH

You work under the supervision of a faculty member, who approves the activity, either as an undergraduate researcher for one semester, or complete an independent study. To get credit, it is required that you complete one of the following:

- Compete in the university Undergraduate Research and Creative Activity Forum.
- Submit your research for presentation at a conference.
- Co-author of a journal or paper.

MULTIDISCIPLINARY EDUCATION

You earn a minor or second major, or work on a two-semester project as part of a multidisciplinary team with student members outside of the College of Engineering.

- Your Academic Success Advisor will verify successful completion of a minor or second major.
- The faculty advisor for your project, as described above, verifies the two-semester project.

LEADERSHIP

To get credit, you 1) participate in a leadership class or documented formal leadership training, then 2) complete an activity where you successfully lead others to an established goal, and then 3) submit a report.

- It is not necessary to complete a course, but COMM 328, IIC 301, PSY 413, HNRS 152F, HNRS 310Q, HNRS 310R, HNRS 310S, HNRS 310T, HNRS 310V, ENGR 501, MGMT 360, IME 664, and MGMT 462 qualify for leadership instruction. (A leadership experience still needs to occur.)
- Opportunities could also exist through the military, your place of employment, or through student involvement. *Please obtain preliminary approval of these activities from your department.* Visit wichita.edu/2020 for a list of possible opportunities.
- Submit a one-page summary report to your department for approval. Deadline will be 2 weeks prior to the end of the term.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND INNOVATION

You successfully compete in an approved entrepreneurial competition, such as the Koch Innovation Challenge, Shocker I-Corp, or Shocker New Ventures Competition; or serve one year as a University Innovation Fellow.

- Department Chair, course instructor of competition, or University Innovation Fellow advisor approves activity.

GLOBAL LEARNING/STUDY ABROAD

You earn a certificate in Global Competency, participate in a global learning project within a class at WSU or complete a credit bearing class in a foreign country where English is not the first language.

- Department approves the activity.

SERVICE LEARNING

You participate in an approved project, or you complete a total of 40 hours of volunteer service, that uses engineering or computer science skillsets and serves a community need. *Please obtain preliminary approval of these activities from your department.*

- Submit a service learning form and one-page summary report to organization advisor or instructor for approval.
- Opportunities may exist for service learning in existing classes and through outreach initiatives and projects (e.g. Engineers Without Borders, STEM Mentor, etc.)
