- 1 WHEREAS 20% - 25% of college women and 15% of college men are victims of forced sex
- 2 during their time in college, and nearly two thirds of college students experience sexual
- harassment, and more than 90% of sexual assault victims on college campuses do not report 3
- the assault therefore; 4
- 5 WHEREAS it is stated by Title IX policy that Wichita State University is required to address
- 6 sexual violence and
- 7 WHEREAS students have the right to choose to report an incident to campus or local law
- 8 enforcement, but it does not relieve the school its duty under Title IX to respond promptly
- 9 and effectively; and
- 10 WHEREAS a school should ensure that a student is aware of their Title IX rights and any
- 11 available resources; and
- 12 WHEREAS many WSU faculty and staff are state mandated reporters; and
- WHEREAS the Student Government Association prioritizes the safety of all Shockers; 13
- 14 therefore
- 15 BE IT RESOLVED that 61st session of student government association will stand in
- 16 solidarity with victims of sexual violence; and
- 17 BE IT RESOLVED Wichita State University has multiple resources for reporting sexual
- 18 harassment and abuse such as the Title IX Office, Care Team, and CUT H8 and CARE
- 19 Team online reporting services, Kitrina Miller The Student Government Association Student
- 20 Advocate, and the University Police Department all of which the 61st session of student
- 21 government associations recommends utilizing as means of reporting if applicable; and
- 22 BE IT RESOLVED if a student does not feel comfortable reporting but still seeks guidance,
- 23 the Counseling and Testing Center provides a range of services designed to help students,
- 24 succeed in their academic, work and personal lives whatever the case may be; and

- 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 61st session will answer any questions to help
- 26 clarify the process of prevention, reporting and investigating of sexual violence; and
- 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that students should be required to take the "Not
- 28 Anymore" sexual assault Title IX online training located in the "Home" tab of your mywsu
- 29 portal; therefore
- 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 61st session of The Student Government
- 31 Association will commit to respecting survivors.
- 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be forwarded with respect to Dr.
- 33 John Bardo; Sarah Myose; Dr. Teri Hall; Student Advocate Kitrina Miller; Jania Kistler,
- 34 Institutional Equity and Compliance; Cathy Williams and Natalia Jaramillo of the Wichita
- 35 Area Sexual Assault Center; Feminists On Campus Uniting Students President Gabby Villar;
- 36 and the Sunflower, the Student Newspaper of Wichita State University.
