Post-9/11 GI Bill® (Chapter 33)

Servicemembers and veterans with at least 90 days of aggregate active duty service on or after 09/11/2001 Servicemembers still serving active duty

Veterans honorably discharged due to sevice-connected disability after 30 days

Post-9/11 Transfer of Entitlement

Eligible servicemembers may transfer all or some unused benefits to a spouse, one or more children, or any combination of spouse and children

Post-9/11 Yellow Ribbon Program

Eligible servicemembers, veterans, and/or dependents who do not qualify for Kansas residency and are eligible for 100% Post-9/11 Education Benefits

Montgomery GI Bill®—Active Duty (MGIB-AD Chapter 30)

Veterans and servicemembers with at least two years of active duty service

Montgomery GI Bill® —Selected Reserve (MGIB-SR Chapter 1606)

Eligible members of the Selected Reserve, including Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard Reserves, and Army and Air National Guard

Survivors and Dependents Educational Assistance Program (DEA Chapter 35)

Eligible dependents of veterans who are permanently and totally disabled due to a service-related condition, or who died while on active duty or as a result of a service-related condition

Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment (VR&E Chapter 31)

Veterans with service-connected disability who are seeking gainful employment Contact the Vocational Rehabilitation Office at Wichita VA Regional Office
